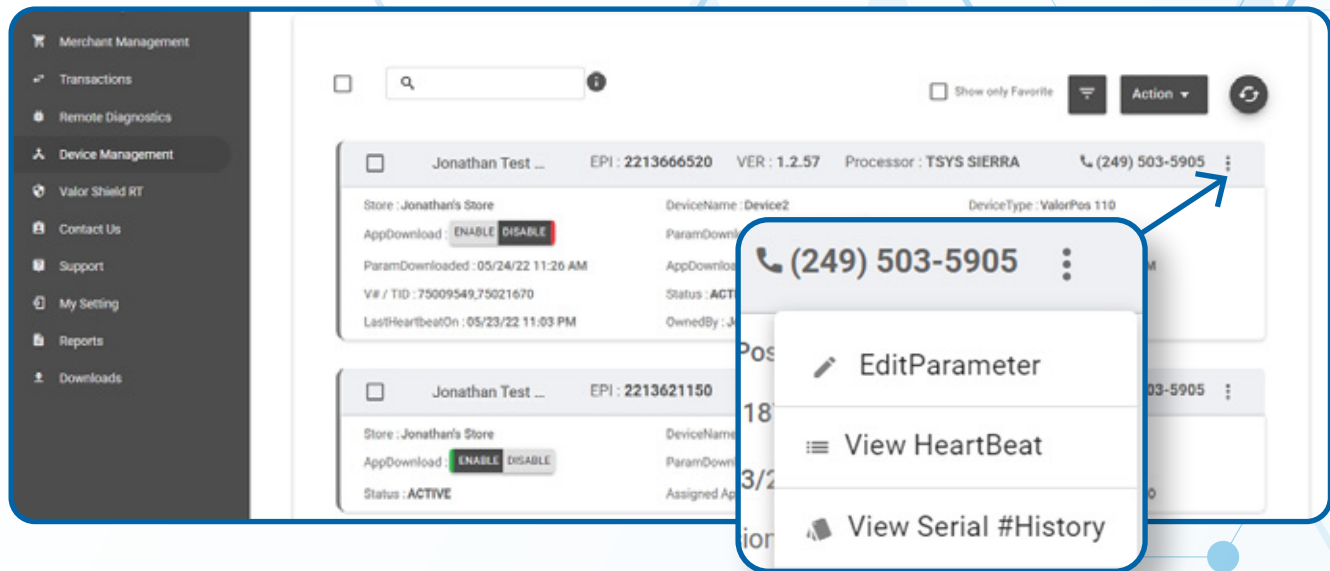

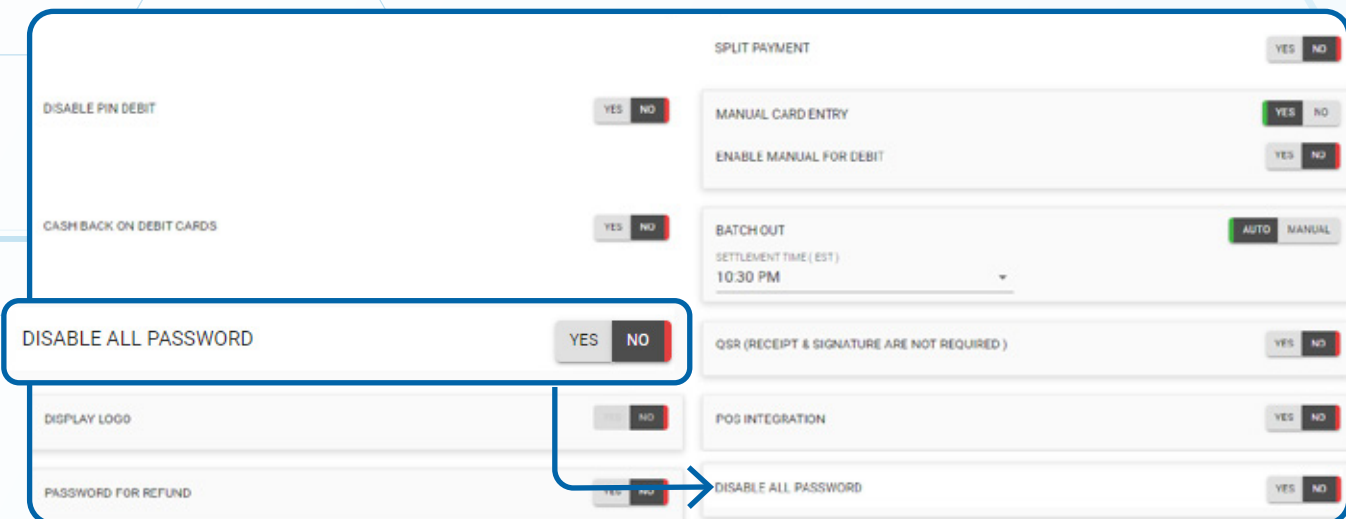
## Step 3

Select the Device you wish to **Disable All Passwords** on by selecting the **Vertical Ellipsis** on the top right-hand corner and select **Edit Parameter** on the device.



## Step 4

You will select **Terminal & Transaction** while in the parameters. To **Disable All Passwords** through the Portal, make sure to select the **Yes** at the bottom right.



## Step 5

Once completed select **Save**.
